Construction overview

Construction is starting this month on the **first area** of **Stage One** of the streetscape project as below.

Monday 5 August to late-October 2024

Memorial Drive - between Bank Arcade and the markets upper terrace.

- Raised pedestrian crossing
- Seating area
- Wayfinding signage
- Upgraded footpath and new pram ramp
- Footpath extension for planting
- Landscaping
- Water fountain and bins
- Roadway/crossing lighting
- Public art - projected lighting.

What to expect during construction

Vehicle, pedestrian and cyclist access will **remain available** to Memorial Drive, Etheridge Street and nearby streets. Access will **remain available** to local businesses and the markets, during standard business and market trading hours.

Large machinery will be in operation and intermittent medium-high level noise can be expected. Dust suppression methods will be utilised as required.

Construction workers' private vehicles will be parked off site, and the construction compound/office located off site.

We thank our community in advance for your cooperation during construction.

Temporary changes to traffic and parking conditions during construction

Two-way traffic will be retained along Memorial Drive. Alternative pedestrian and cyclist pathways may be required at times.

To retain ongoing access to local businesses and the markets, some parking areas must be temporarily closed and/or converted to live traffic lanes. Traffic control will be used as required with signage in place to help redirect motorists.

Alternative free temporary parking has been secured on non-market days during construction.

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.

Temporary free parking during construction

In partnership with ECCO, Council is pleased to advise that additional, free temporary parking will be available at the upper car park area near the roundabout, approximately 200 metres walk from the CWA building. Access is available from Napier Road. Please see the map below.

The car park will be open for free temporary parking from 6am to 6pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. This temporary arrangement will remain in place during construction until further notice

The car park will revert to usual parking arrangements on Wednesdays, Saturdays and Sundays with the boom gates in operation.

Staff parking: Council has received feedback from some local businesses about staff parking in Memorial Drive for extended periods, contrary to signed parking time limits.

To ensure maximum convenience and parking availability for customers, especially during construction, we ask for business owners' assistance to direct staff to park at alternative locations.

Regular parking patrols and enforcement will continue throughout the construction period to ensure compliance with signed parking conditions and to avoid fines.
