### Project overview

Sunshine Coast Council is planning to make the Sugar Road and Maud Street travel corridor (from Bungama Street to Wisers Road), safer and more efficient for all users. The ultimate project will be delivered across multiple stages and include:

- new, separated pathways for walking and riding
- new signalised and raised priority crossings at key intersections
- widening Sugar Road and Maud Street from two to four lanes
- making the area greener and more comfortable and enjoyable for walking and riding
- providing a transport corridor that supports a vibrant, connected and future-ready Maroochydore.

### Night works continuing, Wednesday 1 April - Sugar Road

Underground services investigations are continuing at various locations on Sugar Road and Maud Street. These works cannot take place during the day due to the high volume of traffic on these busy roads.

These investigations determine the exact location of underground services buried underneath the road and footpath surfaces. The information is critical to progressing the detailed design process.

Some night works took place on Maud Street and Sugar Road on Sunday 29 and Tuesday 31 March. The remainder is scheduled to take place on Sugar Road on Wednesday 1 April (weather permitting).

### What to expect

Staff, machinery and vehicles will be on site.

Access will remain available to residences and businesses.

Two-way traffic will remain in operation, sometimes under traffic control.

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.

## Construction notification

Intermittent, medium-level noise can be expected with concrete and asphalt (bitumen) cutting required at times.

Vehicles may be fitted with reversing beepers or squawkers.

Every effort will be made to reduce noise impacts. Nearby residents may choose to close windows, wear ear plugs and/or use fans or air conditioners to help minimise noise.
