Night works

Brisbane Road, Kapala Street, Foote Street and Tarcoola Ave, Mooloolaba

Monday 6 December to Tuesday 21 December 6pm – 6am

All works weather and site conditions permitting

About these works

As part of the Brisbane Road upgrade underground services are being upgraded. This includes water, telecommunications and power.

Recent wet weather has seen some changes made to the construction schedule. As the construction team prepares to cease works over the Christmas-New Year break (24 December 2021 to 3 January 2022), night works will take place at various locations.

Traffic flow will be maintained with some temporary changes to traffic conditions.

These works have been scheduled at night to help minimise inconvenience to the community, including local businesses, and avoid impacting daytime traffic along busy Brisbane Road.

What to expect during these works?

Monday 6 - Thursday 9 December, 6pm-6am. Foote Street. Watermain works.

A trench will be dug across Foote Street, near the Brisbane Road intersection. The trench will be dug in two sections (half the width of the street at a time) to enable traffic to continue along Foote Street.

A new watermain pipe will be installed and the trench filled in. No interruption to water supply is expected.

Monday 6 – Thursday 9 December, 6pm-3am. Brisbane Road, between Walan Street and First Avenue. Telecommunications works.

A machine will dig narrow tunnels under the road. Telecommunication cables will be inserted. No interruption to communication services is expected.

Sunday 19 – Tuesday 21 December, 7pm-3am. Brisbane Road, Kapala Street, Foote Street, Tarcoola Street and Hancock Street/Brisbane Road intersection. Energex works.

Energex will transfer the overhead power network to the new underground network. This includes removal of the old overhead electricity wires and power poles, and commissioning of the new network.

These works require specialist skills, workers and machinery. Up to 25 Energex workers will be on site. Large vehicles including a crane, cherry picker truck and vacuum truck will be in operation.

During all night works intermittent low-medium level noise can be expected including the use of vehicles with reversing beepers. Temporary lighting will be in place for safety reasons.

Safety zones will apply around the construction areas, particularly where power lines or poles are in place.

Access to businesses and residences in the construction zones will remain available. In some cases, alternative footpaths will be made.

Traffic control staff will assist motorists to access driveways where required.

The construction team will make every effort to minimise construction impacts during these works.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

Traffic flow will be maintained throughout the construction zones with traffic control in place as required.

For safety reasons temporary partial lane closures will be in place at times.

Bus services will be maintained.

Reduced speed limits will be in place.

Please allow an extra 5-10 minutes of travel during this period and follow the instructions of traffic control.
