Boat ramp temporarily closed.

No public access to Outrigger Park during construction period.

### Project overview

The Queensland Government and Sunshine Coast Council are upgrading the public boat ramp and trailer parking to provide safe and easy access into one of our region's busiest waterways, the Mooloolah River.

For safety reasons the boat ramp remains closed to the public for the duration of the construction period.

Alternative nearby boat ramps include La Balsa Park, Buddina and Parkyn Parade, Mooloolaba.

### December construction activity

Stage One construction is progressing well.

December activity will see continued work on the new revetment wall, new two-lane boat ramp with floating walkway, and new sealed carpark with 36 car-trailer parks.

The new facility is expected to open in late February/early March 2024.

Stage Two is subject to further investigation and funding. It includes plans for new public amenities.

### Christmas construction break

All construction will pause from Friday 22 December 2023 and restart on Monday 8 January 2024.
