With the recent fine weather assisting construction progress, we are delighted to announce the Northern Parkland will OPEN tomorrow, Friday 24 June, just in time for the June-July Queensland School Holidays.

Site fencing removal and cleaning will occur today. Some minor additional works and adjustments will occur over the coming weeks while the parkland remains open. These include:

- Additional planting
- Playground adjustments
- Remaining wayfinding installation
- Lighting testing and adjustments
