Night works – telecommunications installation

Brisbane Road, Walan Street to First Avenue section

About these works

As part of the Brisbane Road upgrade underground services are being upgraded. This includes telecommunications services.

On Tuesday 14 December from 6pm to 6am, telecommunication conduits (cables) will be installed underground, in the road reserve area along Brisbane Road between Walan Street and First Avenue. The conduits will be laid out along First Avenue as they are installed underground.

These works have been scheduled at night to help minimise inconvenience to the community, including local businesses and residents, and to avoid impacting daytime traffic along busy Brisbane Road.

Traffic flow will be maintained along Brisbane Road with some temporary changes to traffic conditions.

Entry to the Brisbane Road Mooloolaba Central Park N Go car park will remain available.

What to expect during these works?

A machine will dig narrow tunnels under Brisbane Road between Walan Street and Smith Street. Telecommunication conduits will be inserted.

No interruption to communication services is expected.

Large machinery will be in place including tunnel boring machines and trucks.

During these works intermittent low-medium level noise can be expected including the use of vehicles with reversing beepers.

Temporary lighting will be in place for safety reasons.

Safety zones will apply around the construction areas

Access to businesses and residences will remain available. In some cases, alternative footpaths will be in place.

The construction team will make every effort to minimise construction impacts during these works.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions


Traffic flow will be maintained along Brisbane Road and to the Mooloolaba Central Park N Go car park. Traffic control will be in place as required.

For safety reasons temporary partial lane closures will be in place at times.

Bus services will be maintained.

Reduced speed limits will be in place.

Please allow an extra 5-10 minutes of travel during this period and follow the instructions of traffic control.
