Project overview

Sunshine Coast Council is planning to make the Sugar Road and Maud Street travel corridor (from Bungama Street to Wises Road), safer and more efficient for all users. The ultimate project will be delivered across multiple stages and include:

- new, separated pathways for walking and riding
- new signalised and raised priority crossings at key intersections
- widening Sugar Road and Maud Street from two to four lanes
- making the area greener and more comfortable and enjoyable for walking and riding
- providing a transport corridor that supports a vibrant, connected and future-ready Maroochydore.

Interim upgrade works - Sugar Road

As communicated in our last project notification (November 2025), Council is undertaking interim works on Sugar Road, between Oloway Crescent and the Sugar Road-Wises Roads roundabout.

These interim works are being completed ahead of the ultimate (final) design and will help to improve traffic flow and safety in the shorter term, ahead of the longer-term stages for the transport corridor. These interim works include:

- a new, double centre line (replacing the current single centre line)
- extending the length of two northbound (toward the CBD) departure lanes leaving the Wises Road Roundabout along Sugar Road
- moving the merge to a single northbound lane closer to Oloway Crescent
- a new dedicated cycle lane, southbound (toward the Sugar-Wises Roads roundabout)
- to accommodate the new traffic lane, bicycle awareness symbols and cycle lane, removing on-street parking north and southbound, between the Sugar-Wises Roads roundabout and Oloway Crescent intersection.

First stage of interim works - line marking night works on Sugar Road

**Wednesday 21 January and Thursday 22 January
7pm to 5am – weather permitting**

To reduce inconvenience to our community including Sugar Road businesses, the first stage of interim works, line marking changes, will be undertaken at night.

All information contained in this communication is accurate at the time of distribution however works and dates are subject to change due to circumstances outside of Sunshine Coast Council's control.

Construction notification Sugar Road and Maud Street Transport Corridor

During these works Sugar Road will be closed to through traffic in both directions between Oloway Crescent and the Sugar Road-Wises Roads roundabout with detours in place. Please allow extra time for travel.

Local access to homes and businesses in this section of Sugar Road will remain and be managed by traffic control. Intermittent, low-level noise should be expected.

Please see the diagram below for the temporary night road closure, each evening.

Important information - on-street parking (between Sugar-Wises Roads roundabout and Oloway Crescent intersection)

All vehicles parked in this section of Sugar Road must be removed by 6pm Tuesday 20 January to avoid being towed.

Signage will be in place ahead of these works to ensure motorists remain informed. On-street parking will not be returned to this area.

Next stage of interim works – footpath and cycle ramp improvements

We will continue to keep our community informed about the dates and timing for the next stage of interim works, footpath and cycle ramp improvements.
