New Pathway – Lumeah Drive, Mt Coolum Update

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council will be constructing a new footpath along Lumeah Drive, in Mount Coolum.

The new footpath will span from the Mount Coolum Golf Club to Suncoast Beach Drive.

Please refer to the location of works in figure 1 overleaf.

Start date

Works have been rescheduled to start in December as there are conflicts with the works Unitywater are undertaking in the area.

Once Unitywater finish their works the footpath construction will commence. Another project update will be issued once the specific date of commencement is scheduled.

Property access and parking

Property access should not be affected during works. However, if the contractor does require access, then property owners will be notified in advance.

Traffic management

It may be necessary to close the road shoulder to ensure access to the work site. On-street parking may also be limited while works are ongoing.
