#### **A note from your local councillor - Cr Terry Landsberg**

This year's Budget is about making practical choices that make life better for people in Caloundra.

Locals want to see their rates put to good use – fixing what needs fixing, upgrading what's dated and planning sensibly for the future. That's what this Budget focuses on.

Our beaches remain a top priority. Kings Beach continues to earn international recognition, including the Green Flag Award last year. A \$4.2 million investment in the Kings Beach Surf Life Saving facility will improve safety on our second busiest patrolled beach and support visitors from across the region.

Protecting Golden Beach is also critical, with \$6.3 million committed to the Diamond Head seawall to help respond to coastal erosion and impacts of the Bribie Island breakthrough.

We're finally seeing momentum on the Caloundra Transport Corridor Upgrade, with \$26.8 million locked in to improve access to the CBD and ease traffic pressures. This project is being delivered with Queensland Government support, securing that co-funding was essential to getting it moving.

That same partnership is helping deliver the \$5.7 million Caloundra Town Square.

Alongside new accessible amenities at The Events Centre, plus park and playground renewals across Division 2, this Budget is about looking after what we have, supporting our lifestyle and steadily setting Caloundra up for the years ahead.
