Construction update

Sunshine Coast Council and qualified contractors will be undertaking repair works to stabilise and strengthen the landslip at First Bay, Coolum.

Numerous public infrastructure assets were damaged during flooding events in 2022, including a section of cliff face above the beach at First Bay. These works have been jointly funded by Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA).

Council worked with the Queensland Reconstruction Authority (QRA) to secure funding to repair damaged civil assets with jointly funded DRFA assistance. This is one of 15 landslips across the Sunshine Coast repaired using DRFA funding.

Program and timing

Works include the repair of 145 metres of public footpath on the eastern side of David Low Way at First Bay, Coolum, and landslip stabilisation works to the cliff face above the beach.

Landslip repair works are scheduled to take place from Monday 20 January to Monday 30 June 2025. Works will begin at 7.00am and conclude by 5.00pm, Monday through Friday (except public holidays). Limited night works will be necessary at the start and end of the project for traffic management and safety.

This will include setting up road barriers and constructing an accessible ramp and pedestrian refuge at the corner of Mona Vista Court and David Low Way.

Post-construction asphalt paving and line marking works will be undertaken at night for the safety of workers on site (estimated three nights).

Completion of these works is dependent on weather and site conditions, with potential unforeseen delays in the event of significant wet weather periods.

Changes to traffic conditions

Throughout the project, beach access to First Bay and Second Bay will be maintained, however First Bay beach access may be temporarily unavailable in the final project stage to allow safe access for machinery.

Traffic management and pedestrian safety controls will be in place. Two-way traffic will be maintained through the site, with a reduction in traffic speed from 50KPH to 40KPH and temporary closure of Hansen's Lookout car park and on-street parking spaces on David Low Way.

Please follow the directions of on-site traffic controllers and signage for your own safety and the safety of others. Please do not climb temporary fencing or access work site areas for safety reasons. Members of the public gaining or attempting to gain unauthorised access

through temporary fencing and barriers may be liable for prosecution.

We recognise these works may cause frustration for residents and visitors, however these temporary changes to traffic and pedestrian access are necessary to ensure the safety of workers and the public while repair works are underway, and to provide continued flow of traffic along David Low Way.
