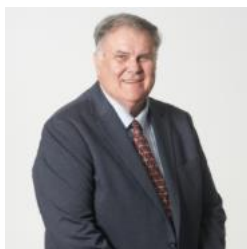


Capital works highlights for Division 5

A note from your local councillor - Cr Winston Johnston

Across Division 5, this year's Budget focuses on investing in what matters most to our community, while endeavouring to deliver best value for every dollar spent.

I'm proud to share a range of projects in Budget 2026-27 that will strengthen our hinterland lifestyle and improve connectivity, while continuing to enhance the spaces we regularly use. These projects cover transport upgrades, improvements to parks and gardens, and renewed community facilities and buildings.

Key transport investments will improve safety, accessibility and how we move through our towns. This includes \$1.78 million for the Christensens Road upgrade in Hunchy and an additional \$1.6 million to finalise the completion of the Maple Street streetscape in Maleny.

We are also investing in essential community infrastructure, including \$300,000 to renew the Hill Street public amenities in Woombye and more than \$180,000 to upgrade Kolora Park amenities in Palmwoods. Roof renewals are also planned for Maleny Library (\$250,000) and the netball facility in West Woombye (\$190,000).

Our parks, gardens and natural reserves remain a priority. Funding will support upgrades at park locations across Division 5 including Conondale, Diamond Valley, Palmwoods, Woombye and Mooloolah Valley. There's \$380,000 allocated to Maroochy Regional Bushland Botanical Gardens and \$160,000 to Mary Cairncross track. A further \$1.25 million will progress the Maleny Community Precinct, including new pathways.
