About these works

From early February through to mid-April 2026, fencing relocation and landscaping works will take place at the Caloundra RSL Club and Caloundra Masonic Lodge.

These activities include:

- Relocating the existing private property fencing to the correct boundary line
- Modification and installation of landscape treatments.

Property access will be maintained.

Council will liaise directly with the RSL, Masonic Lodge and nearby residents as required.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions

For the safety of our community and workers, some temporary changes to traffic conditions will be in place during these works.

They include:

- Intermittent short-term lane closures on Third Avenue, Arthur Street and Olm Street (as required)
- Reduced speed limits around active work zones
- Intermittent footpath closures, with alternative pedestrian detours in place
- Construction vehicles entering and exiting the site
- Intermittent to low-mid level noise
- Traffic control and signage in place (as required).

Every effort will be made to minimise inconvenience to motorists, pedestrians, and local businesses.

Please allow a few minutes of extra travel time during this period of works.
