



## Mooloolaba Foreshore Revitalisation Northern Parkland

Mooloolaba

-  Tuesday 3 October to early November (weather and site conditions permitting)  
Monday to Friday 7am – 5pm
-  Maintenance works, turf replacement, garden improvements.

### Maintenance overview

Since officially opening over one year ago the Northern Parkland has proven incredibly popular with residents and visitors.

The recent school holidays and ideal weather conditions have seen high level usage of the parkland along with events such as the IronMan 70.3 festival using the new community space.

Unfortunately, there has also been some vandalism and damage, including vegetation impacted by people running or sliding down the planted embankment and damage to the irrigation systems and lights.

The grassed areas have experienced extensive compaction along with drainage issues.

During October and early November Council will undergo maintenance works including:

- Installing new turf – including improved drainage
- Undertaking additional maintenance to the irrigation system, parkland furniture and lights
- Stabilising the embankment and planting new vegetation (behind the barbecue shelter).

These works have been timed to minimise inconvenience to our community by taking place after the September Queensland School Holidays and October King's Birthday Public Holiday.

All works will be complete before the second Mooloolaba Foreshore Festival which takes place on Saturday November 4, 2023. The festival is a free community event. Click [HERE](#) for more details.

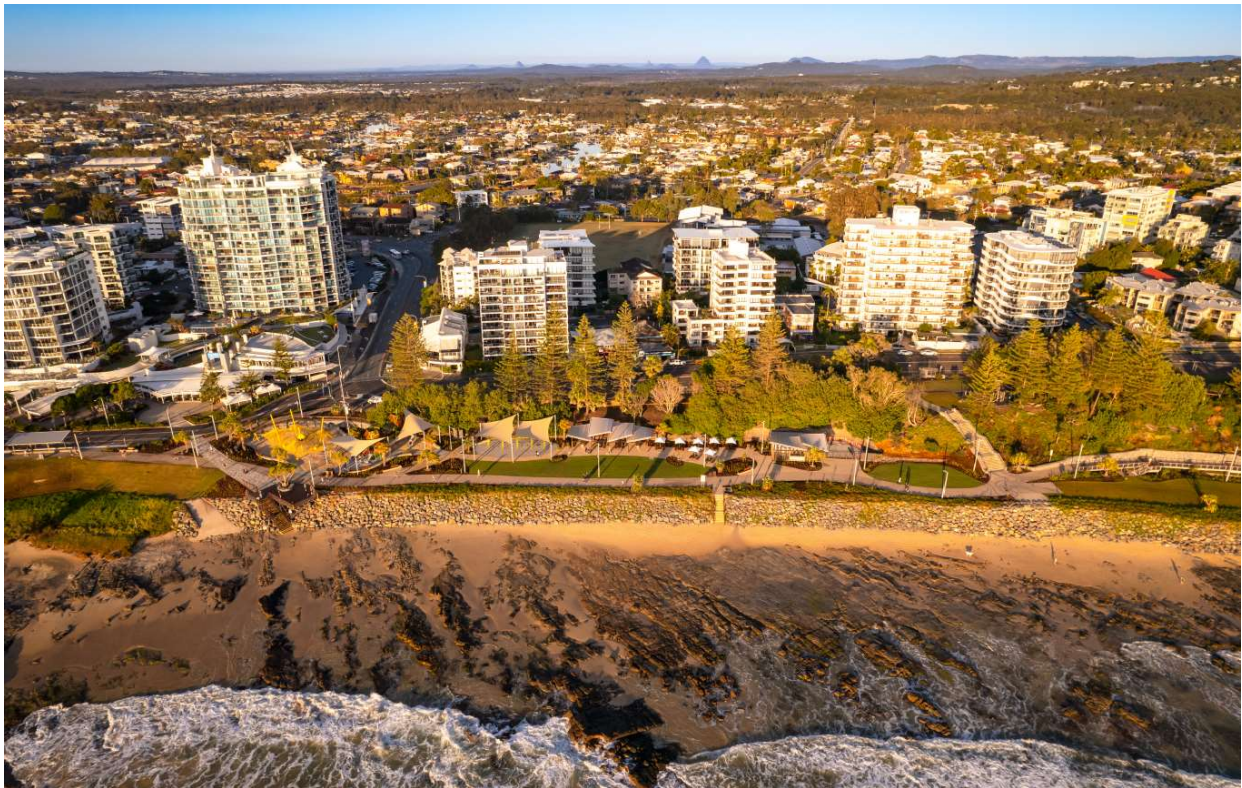
## What to expect during these works

The newly turfed area will be fenced off for a period of approximately three weeks for safety reasons and to allow the turf to establish and grow.
