# MAROOCHYDORE CITY CENTRE PROJECT ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES AND AUTHORITIES

#### 1. Sunshine Coast Council (Council)

The key **roles** of Council in the delivery of the Project are:

- Land owner
- Land developer
- Project financier
- · Developed public realm asset owner.

The key responsibilities and authorities of Council in the delivery of the project are:

- · Appointment and replacement of SunCentral board members
- Approval of the Maroochydore Priority Development Area Infrastructure Agreement for lodgment by SunCentral to MEDQ
- Approval of Stage Development Plans and related business cases
- Approval of Land Disposal Plans
- Approval of the annual Council budget for all costs incurred by Council for the Maroochydore City Centre Project
- Annual approval through Council's annual budget process of a Development Management Fee payable to SunCentral.

# 2. Minister for Economic Development Queensland (MEDQ)

The key **role** of MEDQ in the delivery of the Project is Assessment Manager.

The key responsibilities and authorities of MEDQ in the delivery of the project are:

- · assessment and approval of
  - Infrastructure Agreement
  - Precinct plans
  - Community Development Plan
  - o Operational Works (if applicable)
  - Reconfiguration of Lot
  - Car Parking Management Strategy
  - Material Change of Use.

#### 3. SunCentral Pty Ltd (SunCentral)

The key roles of SunCentral in the delivery of the Project are to:

- Manage and administer development management services
- Achieve an appropriate balance between commercial and non-commercial functions

- Facilitate development of the Priority Development Area to:
  - o attract investment and the sale of land on a commercial basis
  - aid the establishment of a 21<sup>st</sup> century regional city centre
  - create an identifiable city heart for the wider Sunshine Coast
  - o deliver land to accommodate community and civic facilities
  - Enable delivery of key infrastructure and
  - Provide a catalyst for economic development.

The key responsibilities and authorities of SunCentral in the delivery of the project are:

- Provide advice to Council on the Project
- Provide development management services as contracted by Council including:
  - Infrastructure Agreement MEDQ approval process
  - Precinct Plans development and MEDQ approval process
  - Any further changes to the Development Scheme in the Priority Development Area
  - Any Reconfiguration of a Lot within the Priority Development Area
  - Any other application for approval under the relevant planning instruments
  - Development of Stage Development Plans and related business cases for submission to Council
  - Development of Land Disposal Plans for submission to Council
  - Land acquisition recommendations
  - Design works
  - Building works
  - Drainage works
  - Operational works
  - Plumbing works
  - Estate maintenance works
  - Advertising and marketing works
  - Sales management works
- Promote, facilitate, carry out and control the creation, disposal and management of Council owned land within the Maroochydore City Centre PDA
- · Ensure the financial viability and statutory compliance of SunCentral Pty Ltd.

# 4. Shareholders Reference Group (SRG)

The key **role** of the SRG in the delivery of the Project is to act as Council's shareholder representative to SunCentral.

The key **responsibilities and authorities** of the SRG in the delivery of the project are:

- Manage the delivery by SunCentral of requirements under the Statement of Corporate Intent
- Undertake performance reviews of the SunCentral Board
- · Oversight of the awarding of development services contracts with SunCentral for

- Development of Stage Development Plans
- Development of Land Disposal Plans
- Development and lodgement of planning instruments
- Provision of Development Services
- The marketing of land in accordance with Council approved Land Disposal Plans
- Approve any planning instruments for lodgement to MEDQ
- Approve contracts for the sale of specific parcels of land in accordance with Council approved Land Disposal Plans.

# 5. Technical Reference Group (TRG)

The key <u>role</u> of the TRG in the delivery of the Project is to manage and administer the technical design and specification of all constructed Council owned assets related to the Project.

The key responsibilities and authorities of the SRG in the delivery of the project are:

- Preparation of the Maroochydore City Centre PDA Infrastructure Agreement
- Define technical specifications for
  - Design works
  - Building works
  - Drainage works
  - Operational works
  - Plumbing work
  - Estate maintenance work
  - Electrical works
  - o Telecommunications works
- Approve all design works completed by SunCentral.

### 6. SCC Project Superintendent

The key <u>role</u> of the SCC Project Superintendent is to manage the contractual arrangements between Council and SunCentral.

The key responsibilities of the SCC Project Superintendent are:

- Provide direct Council liaison with SunCentral for the day to day delivery of all contractual works
- Provide contract administration functions for all Council/SunCentral contracts
- · Provide monthly project contract status reports to the SRG
- Recommend SunCentral development services contract progress payments for SRG approval.
