
Mooloolaba Beach:

Implementation

| Date | Activity |
|---------------------------------------|---|
| 16 November 2020 | Application process opens and is advertised on council's website and social media |
| 11 December 2020 | Applications close |
| 12 December 2020 – 15 January 2021 | Council officers assess applications, and circulate the successful applicant to stakeholders for final feedback and conditioning |
| 18 January 2021 – 22 January 2021 | Council officers notify applicants of the decision and issue the permit to the successful applicant to commence within three (3) months of notification |
| 2022 | Reassess activity and location for inclusion in the 2022 – 2025 High-Use / High-Impact Permit Process |
