That Council issue a PRELIMINARY APPROVAL WITH CONDITIONS under Section 241 of the Sustainable Planning Act 2009 for Reconfiguration of a Lot - Residential (1 lot into 129 lots plus road, conservation reserve, park and common property) at 3-7 Fishermans Road and 31 Martins Drive, Kuluin, in accordance with the details contained within Appendix A and the following additional conditions:

#### **ENGINEERING**

#### Construction Traffic

- 8. Construction and earthworks activities must only occur between the hours of 7.00am and 6.00pm Monday to Saturday. Haulage activities and the entry and departure of heavy vehicles must only occur between the hours of 7.00am and 6.00pm Monday to Friday excluding public holidays. During the operational works for the subdivision, all construction vehicles must enter and exit the site directly from and to Maroochydore Road Service Road or Charlston Place. Construction vehicles are not permitted to access the site via Renison Drive. Further:
  - (a) Unmade entrances, access roads and parking areas used by construction traffic must be stabilised to minimise erosion and prevent tracking mud by following Healthy Waterways Best Practice Guidelines for the Control of Stormwater Pollution from Building Sites.
  - (b) Stabilisation of construction entrances must be a priority and the first step in preventing sediment or silted water escaping the construction site and must be arranged so that all traffic exiting the site is required to travel over a rumble pad or other device to prevent soil or sediment entering Council infrastructure.
  - (c) Any sediment transported or escaped to a roadway, gutter or footway must be removed immediately by sweeping. Collected sediment must be removed to a containment area on site.
  - (d) Roadways, gutters and footways must not be cleaned by washing or flushing into Council's stormwater drains

#### New Roads

- 9. The new road connecting Martins Drive to Charlston Place must be constructed in accordance with the conditions of this Decision Notice and dedicated as road reserve at no cost to Council, prior to plan sealing for the first stage of the development.
- 10. The new road connecting Martins Drive to Charlston Place must be constructed to a minimum standard prior to plan sealing for the first stage of the development,

and then upgraded to full local street standard prior to plan sealing for the second stage of the development. The works must be undertaken in accordance with an Operational Works approval and for the first stage of the development must include in particular a reserve width of 16.5 metres

- (a) sealing to a minimum width of 6 metres.
- (b) Turfed verge with table drains

For the second stage of the development the works must include in particular:

- (c) sealing, kerbing and channelling
- (d) a cross-section profile matching that of a Local Street in accordance with Planning Scheme Policy No. 6 Transport Traffic and Parking)
- (e) construction of pedestrian footpaths in accordance with the conditions of a Development Permit for the development
- (f) provision of on-street carparking
- (g) installation of street lighting
- 11. A new intersection must be constructed joining the new road with Charlston Place. The works must be undertaken in accordance with an Operational Works approval.
