The network blueprint recommendations within the Recreation Trail Plan 2012 have been prepared based on the following four categories

1. partnering/advocacy- forming relationships and liaison with external stakeholders, negotiations relating to property acquisition/access

2. **planning** - where a potential trail has been identified investigation of the trail alignment, ground truthing to determine any constraints

or alternative routes and liaison with relevant land managers, user groups and adjoining residents is required

3. **upgrades** - works required to be undertaken on existing signed trails

4. **new -** the planning has been completed and a new trail is to be either costed, designed and/or installed

For each of those categories Table A below provides:

Indicative Allocations
those funds currently identified within Council's capital works program or levy programs allocated to recreation trail development

Estimated Costs - the approximate cost to enable the blueprint network recommendations to be undertaken

Funds Required - is the difference between what is currently allocated within councils budget and what is required

In relation to the upgrade or development of new recreation trails **Table A** separates the costs associated with the upgrade and development of coastal pathway and shared strategic transport pathways separately to enable the cost of all other recreation trails to be clearly identifiable.
