Marine traffic control in place as required.

Overview

Construction is continuing on the remaining two lanes of the new 26.4 metre wide, four lane bridge over Mayes Canal, Brisbane Road. When complete, the new bridge will feature four traffic lanes (two lanes each way) a shared pedestrian and cycle paths on both sides, a timber viewing platform, and have the same clearance as the current bridge.

Over the next few months however construction activity will mean that the clearance of the bridge will be **temporarily reduced by approximately 350mm**.

Flags, lighting and signage will be in place however marine vessels are advised to take note of the new temporary (reduced) clearance and conditions.

Being mindful of Mayes Canal's location and environmental sensitivities including parkland and marine areas, all construction is being performed under the relevant environmental conditions and management plans. Marine vessel access will remain available during construction.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions – marine vessels

Marine traffic – reduced clearance

During the next few months the clearance of the bridge will be temporarily reduced by approximately 350mm.

Flags, lighting and signage will be in place.

Please take note of the new conditions.

Mayes Canal remains open to marine vessels

Mayes Canal will remain open to marine vessels.

For safety reasons, there may be some brief periods of time when vessels will not be able to motor/sail/paddle under the bridge during construction activity.

Please allow an extra 10 minutes for marine travel where possible.
