Construction – night works

Large quantities of construction materials and specialist machinery are required to construct the new pedestrian and cycle bridge.

In consideration of our community's safety and to minimise traffic disruptions during the day, some construction works must be actioned at night.

On the evenings of Wednesday 3 and Thursday 4 April, between the hours of 7pm and 5am, construction materials will be transferred from the Central Drive construction compound to the new bridge construction site (adjacent to the Sunshine Motorway).

During these evenings, a small excavator and truck will be operating. While every effort will be made to ensure noise is kept to a minimum, adjacent residents are advised to expect intermittent, medium level noise whilst materials are loaded and transported between the two locations.

All traffic movements will remain open on the existing bridge and Sunshine Motorway.

These works have been scheduled to take place after the Easter holiday period to minimise impacts on our community. Council apologises in advance for any inconvenience.
