### Stringybark Road Pedestrian and Cycle Bridge

Sight works – new pedestrian and cycle bridge construction

- Week commencing Sunday 7 April and throughout April as required. Sunday to Thursday nights only, 7pm to 5am each evening/morning \*All works are subject to weather and construction material/equipment availability.
  - Sunshine Motorway and Stringybark Road Bridge, spanning Buderim and Sippy Downs

Intermittent changes to traffic conditions as required for safety reasons.

#### Construction overview – night works

In consideration of our community's safety and to minimise daytime traffic disruption along busy Stringybark Road Bridge and the Sunshine Motorway, some construction activity for the new pedestrian and cycle bridge must take place at night.

Starting from the week commencing Sunday 7 April intermittent night works will commence from Sunday to Thursday evenings (inclusive) under the existing Stringybark Road vehicle bridge, adjacent to the Sunshine Motorway.

Works will take place between the hours of 7pm and 5am and include the installation of temporary barriers and access areas in preparation for the new bridge's construction.

While every effort will be made to ensure noise is kept to a minimum, adjacent residents are advised to expect intermittent noise.

# Temporary changes to traffic conditions at night

To ensure our community's safety, temporary road barriers will be installed on the road shoulder of the

Sunshine Motorway, and under the existing Stringybark Road Bridge and its approaches.

Traffic movements will remain open on the Sunshine Motorway and existing Stringybark Road bridge, however some temporary changes to traffic conditions including lane closures will take place as required.

Traffic control will be operating and signage will be in place.

Please allow a few extra minutes of travel time during these night works and follow the instructions of traffic controllers. Council apologises in advance for any inconvenience.
