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

Budget Review 1 2020/21 identifies and proposes funding for a project within the Maleny Showground Precinct and I am the President of the Maleny Show Society.

Appendix B to the report includes Project K1036 - Ocean Street – Lighting Upgrade – Replace current lighting with LED.

As noted in my Register of Interests, I am a shareholder and director of a corporation that holds an interest in the Duporth Tavern which is situated at 52-62 Duporth Avenue, Maroochydore.

I am advised however, that the project appearing in Appendix B of this report relates to lighting assets in Ocean Street, not the adjacent Duporth Avenue.

I also note that this report is a Budget Review report and that under section 175E (1) (b) of the Local Government Act 2009, the conflict of interest obligations in section 175E do not apply if the matter to be considered is an Ordinary Business Matter.

An Ordinary Business Matter is defined in Schedule 4 of the Act to include:

a resolution required for the adoption of a budget for the local government

Notwithstanding the project is in Ocean Street – not Duporth Avenue – and the fact that this report would be considered to be an Ordinary Business matter, out of an abundance of caution, I am making this declaration of a potential perceived conflict of interest in a matter that is referenced in Agenda Item 8.10.

I have also formed the view that given the nature of the interest, I believe I can appropriately manage any perceived conflict, should it exist, and that I can impartially make a decision in the public interest on the matter before Council today.

I will now ask the Deputy Mayor to assume the chair so that you may deliberate on this matter and make the necessary determinations under section 175E (4) of the Local Government Act 2009.
