COUNCILLOR COMMENT

Montville Village Association is a voluntary organisation that looks after the Montville Village Hall, which is owned, managed and maintained by the residents of Montville.

The Montville Hall Association was successful in receiving a grant of \$50,000 from the State Government under the condition that they raised dollar for dollar.

The Association has sold tickets, received bequeaths and donations and has even begged, borrowed but not stolen in their efforts to raise this much

needed cash. They are exhausted from their efforts and are just short \$5,000 off meeting the State Government requirement for the funding.

The Montville Village Hall began life as a School of Arts Hall in 1898. Over the years it has been managed by the Country Women's Association and the Returned Servicemen's League before being deeded to the Montville Village Association. It was heritage listed in 2009 and is regarded as one of the more significant, historic buildings in the iconic precinct from Mapleton to Montville.

This is a significant and iconic structure that needs to be maintained for future generation to appreciate and utilise.
