New Public Amenities – Jack Morgan Park, Coolum Beach

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to maintaining and improving our parks and recreational spaces across our region.

As part of these ongoing improvements, a new public amenity block will be installed at Jack Morgan Park in Coolum Beach.

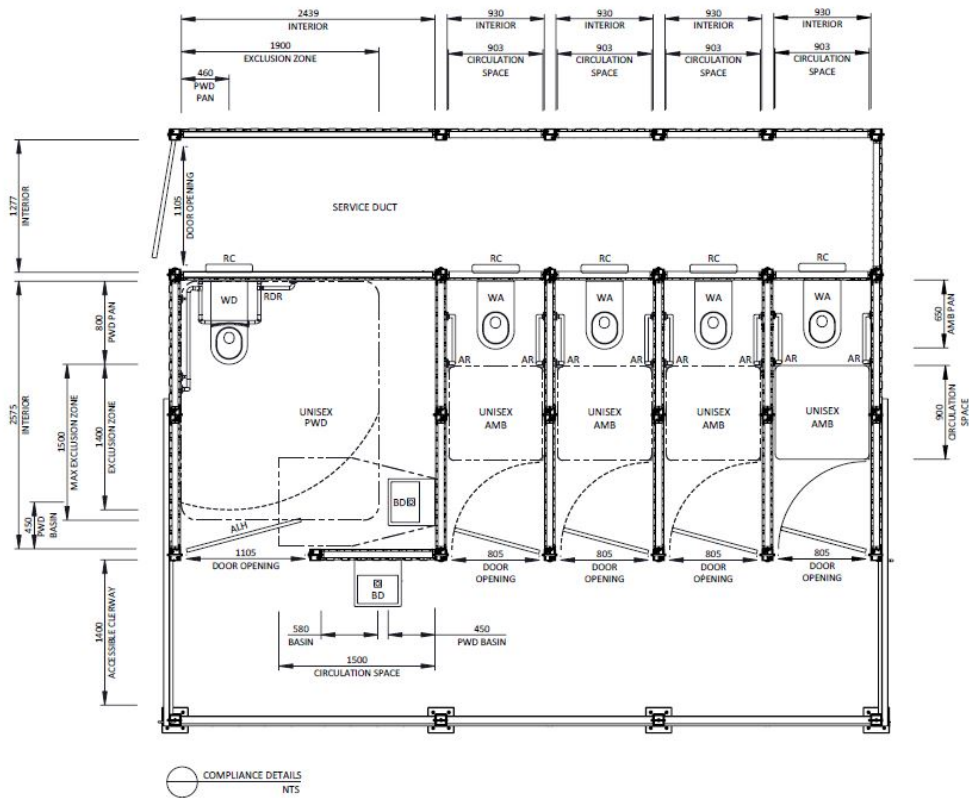


Figure 2: Public amenity design

The new public amenities will consist of one disability compliant toilet and four ambulant toilets. Please refer to figure 1 and 2 overleaf.

There will be no impact or removal of nearby trees for this new facility.

Start date

Work is scheduled to commence Monday 20 November 2023 and are expected to be completed by February 2024.

Construction works will cease over the Christmas and New Year period between 22 December 2023 and 8 January 2024.

Park access and parking

Temporary fencing will be set up around the work site for the duration of the project. There will be no impact to access or parking.

All park facilities will remain open to the public at all times.

Figure 1: Layout of public amenity
