

Item 8.4 Compliance and Enforcement Policy



Policy purpose

Council has a Compliance and Enforcement Policy to:

- provide an overarching view on how the community can expect Council to deal with compliance
- guide officers through a consistent approach to education, compliance, and enforcements in our community
- inform how Council will focus resources when dealing with compliance-based issues

Overview

As an overview the Policy:

- acknowledges that most of our community are voluntarily self-compliant
- keeps education and guidance as a first step where possible
- steps out action which is proportionate to the risk
- confirms Council's commitment to being transparent and making informed decisions
- acknowledges that we have an established approach for some compliance issues

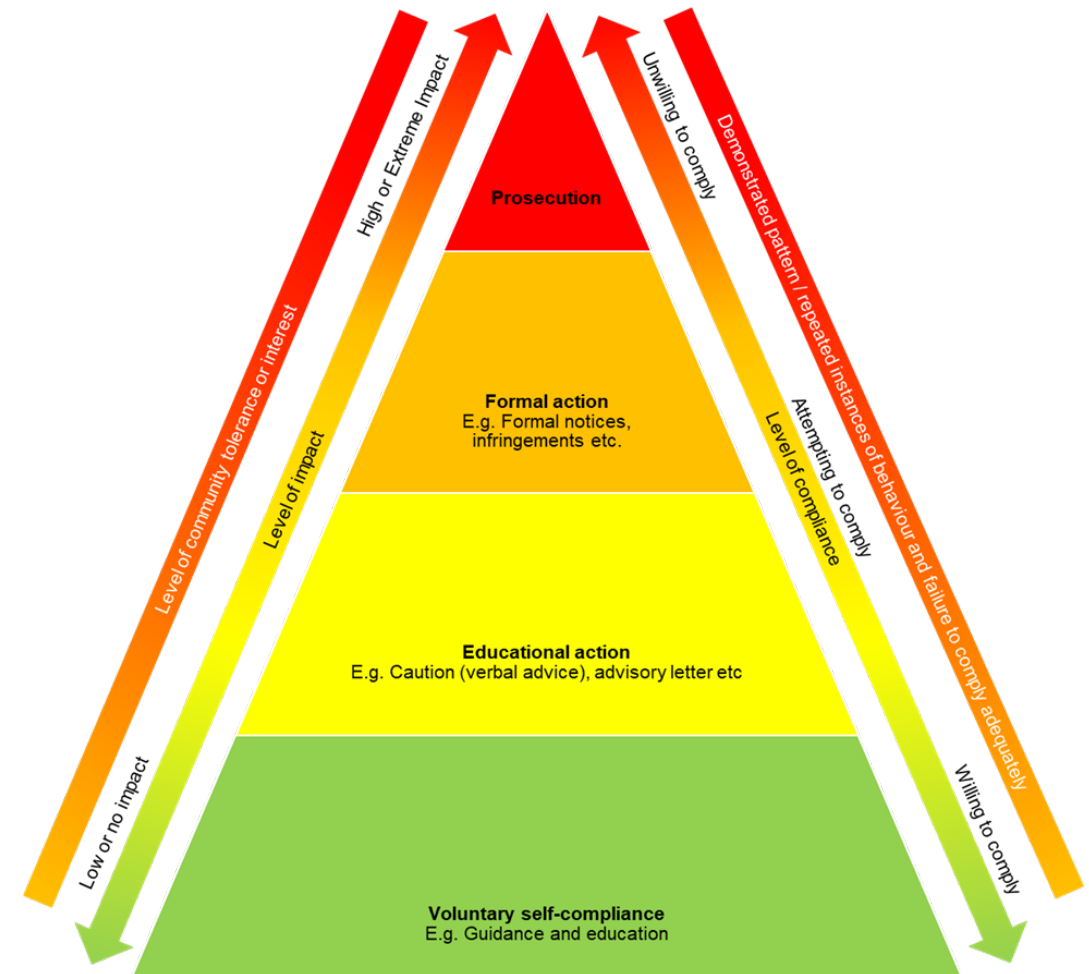


Figure 1 – Compliance model
