How to use these maps

This Access Map provides information about street access, accessible services and facilities within the Caloundra Town Centre.

Information on this map includes where to find accessible parking, toilets, pathways, seats, telephones, medical/health services, ATM's and public transport.

There is a Legend Key that provides a simple explanation of the symbols used on this map. Unless the Access Map indicates Steep Gradient or No Pathway it can be understood that there is a pathway that is considered to be traversable by people with disability.

Icons, pathways and services are shown within an approximate location. This map has been developed during an onsite inspection and cross referenced with GIS data. Community services that have been listed give a grid reference relating to their location.

The good crossing point icon has been used to show where there are good kerb ramps and pedestrian zebra crossings. These crossing points may have elements that do not fully comply with Australian Standards and are to be used according to each person's ability.
