Brisbane Road Car Park Redevelopment

Notice to businesses, residents and motorists Safety measures and additional site sheds to construction site

Construction on the \$18 million Brisbane Road Car Park redevelopment in Mooloolaba is progressing on schedule. The multi-deck car park is expected to be completed by December 2020.

The following safety measures have been implemented to the construction site to prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- physical distancing of 1.5 metres between workers wherever possible
- for indoor work, there should be no more than one person per four square metres
- minimising the use of shared tools.
 Where used, tools are to be cleaned regularly
- Regularly cleaning site amenities, including lunch rooms, site offices and toilets

As a further measure to ensure the health and safety of construction workers a small section of the car park adjacent to Brisbane Road will be temporarily used for additional site sheds.

The additional site sheds will enable workers to keep the required physical distance of at least 1.5 metres, complying with the indoor limit of one person for every four square metres.

This temporary measure is only required while the COVID-19 restrictions are in place and reduced parking demand is evident in Mooloolaba. During this temporary arrangement the car park adjacent to Brisbane Road will remain open to the general public.
