Mooloolaba Foreshore Revitalisation Project – Stage Two

May 2024

Mooloolaba's foreshore revitalisation will proceed after being given the green light by Sunshine Coast Council.

Stage Two construction will begin from February 2025 on, which will include more beachfront parkland, new accessible pathways and viewing deck, improved access to the beach and foreshore, enhanced community spaces, new modern public amenities and a terraced seawall.

A new <u>fly-through video</u> has been released showcasing a different perspective of the upcoming rejuvenation of the Central Meeting Place and Southern Parkland seawall replacement.

Stage Two follows on from the completion of the hugely successful, multi award winning first stage, the <u>Northern Parklands</u> and will ensure Mooloolaba thrives as a wonderful destination for Sunshine Coast residents and visitors, and is better protected from the predicted impacts of climate change.

Council meeting decision

The latest Council meeting (May 30), was an opportunity for the project team to provide Councillors and our community with a further update on the Mooloolaba Foreshore Revitalisation project, which was endorsed last year (January 25 2023).

This included providing an update on the community engagement history, key project drivers and the design and delivery of the project, specifically around Stage Two Central Meeting Place and Southern Seawall.

The new Council accepted the recommendations in the report and approved the design, the construction timing for Stage Two and the finalisation of the Draft Business Activation Plan to begin implementation within the 2024-25 financial year.

This means the transformational project will now progress in line with the Master Plan and the 2022 Central Meeting Place community supported concept blue outcomes.





Business Activation Plan

Council has reinforced its commitment to helping businesses, community, sporting groups and residents plan for the Stage Two construction phase.

Two groups have assisted this process– the Mooloolaba Business Activation Group and Mooloolaba Stakeholder Interest Group.

The groups have met on a number of occasions giving the project team an opportunity to unpack the design, to listen and to work with the business community in developing a draft Business Activation Plan.

Council approved the finalisation of the activation plan which aims to activate Mooloolaba and encourage businesses to continue to attract locals and visitors before, during and after Stage Two construction, as well as share the future vision for this regionally significant project.
