Construction overview

Construction is continuing on the new 160-metrelong section of Caloundra Headland Coastal Pathway Boardwalk. This section forms part of a total 73 kilometre long coastal pathway route from Bells Creek in the south to Coolum in the north.

Temporary changes to traffic conditions – The Esplanade and Centaur Park

The Esplanade – reopened to traffic and remaining open during the Queensland school holiday period

The Esplanade and adjacent walking path have reopened to vehicles and pedestrians. It will remain open for the duration of the Queensland School Holidays.

Further temporary closures will be required in the future with advance notice provided to our community.

Until June 2024. Temporary Centaur Park access road and car park closure

Pedestrian access remains to the park.

For safety reasons the access road and car park area remains temporarily closed to vehicles until the completion of the project, estimated as June 2024.

Parking is available in nearby streets.

Christmas – New Year construction break

All construction activity will cease from Friday 22 December and recommence on Monday 8 January 2024.

January 2024 Works

January construction activity will see works continuing on the retaining walls and concrete pathways.

These works have been timed to ensure minimal impacts to pedestrians and vehicle traffic over the peak holiday period.

We will provide a further construction update in late January/early February 2024 however February will see boardwalk construction commence.
