## **COUNCILLOR COMMENT**

Several years ago the Nambour Wildcats were forced to leave their home grounds at St John's College, Perwillowen. At the time when they left Nambour, they had over 400 members.

They have been operating out of the Mudjimba Multi Sports Complex for several years now and their membership numbers have dropped down to 136. Early this year the new President, Ronnie McKenzie, asked for my assistance to get the Club back to Nambour before the Club is forced to close because of the continuing membership decline.

We managed to get two locations for the Club's consideration, the Nambour PCYC and the Nambour State College.

The Club chose the Nambour PCYC and the initial rapport with the resident Officer in Charge has been excellent.

However as the club is starting afresh at a completely new venue which hasn't had soccer played there before, the Club needs all the assistance it can get.

The above mentioned second hand Council Commercial Mower has been identified surplus to needs (Stock number 263907), and is to be disposed of at public auction this month.

The Nambour Wildcats would like to purchase the mower at an agreed price based on the "written down value" and independent valuation, prior to it proceeding to action.

I would like to provide up to \$5,000.00 from my Discretionary Funds towards the mower purchase, however should the price be more than this amount, the Nambour Wildcats will have the option to fund the shortfall, or decide to not proceed with the purchase of the mower.
