Dear Chris

It is with pleasure that I fully support your application with the Sunshine Coast Regional Council for approval to increase the usage of "The Studio" to cater for daytime events at your beautiful property.

As Noosa's leading destination company in Event Management for private clientele, Events of Noosa are constantly contacted daily by potential clients from all over the world who are wishing to have their wedding or event in Noosa, only to be turned away to another destination such as Port Douglas, Byron Bay or Gold Coast as Noosa currently does not have a unique property in which to showcase high end events.

This is an incredibly frustrating situation from our point of view as we are constantly trying to promote Noosa as a fantastic location for a special event, but we are finding more and more that Noosa is unable to cater for high end unique events and we as a tourist destination are loosing this potential business. We in essence turn away a third of the enquiries we receive to other destinations because Noosa just doesn't have venues suitable to offer to high end clientele. Even though they really want to come to Noosa for their event.

"The Studio" at Cooroy Mountain Park, is an extremely unique venue that I have received interest from national and international businesses to use for high end, one off events. But again have had to turn this business to other destinations as this venue isn't currently available. It was architecturally designed by John Mainwaring, and at a cost of \$1m is a world class venue to host events with the location affords some of the best hinterland views including being next to Cooroy Mountain.

Should "The Studio" be able to cater for daytime events, this could in essence bring quite a volume of income to Noosa that was previously lost to other destinations. This not only includes direct event spend, but for the large number of people each client brings with them to the region, they all require accommodation sometimes for up to a week, they eat out 3 times a day and of course shop in the local areas and take advantage of tours etc. We have had up to 70 events on our books each year, with an average of 60 guests to each event, this equates to an extra 4200 people coming into Noosa from Events of Noosa events alone who bring extra income to this region. These unique features will draw customers from rival locations.

We wish you all the very best with your application and would be more than happy to discuss these issues further with any interested parties.
