Capital works highlights for Division 3

- \$5 million to progress the Honeyfarm Road Sports and Recreation Precinct
- \$550,000 to implement the Kawana Regional Aquatic Centre Master Plan Report
- \$450,000 to design and construct public amenities at Frank McIvor Park and Dorothy Anderson Park with completion in 2023
- \$300,000 to prevent and remediate corrosion of Lake Kawana Finishing Tower, Bokarina
- \$250,000 to replace existing chiller at Venue 114, Bokarina
- \$250,000 to install new lighting along Meridan Way, Meridan Plains
- \$220,000 to extend the Bokarina-Warana Coastal Pathway to John Hotton Park, Bokarina
- \$200,000 to replace two heat pumps in the 25m pool at Kawana Aquatic Centre
- \$200,000 to start design on upgrading Creekside Boulevard and Saffron Drive intersection
- \$177,000 to seal concrete on bridges in coastal environments to prevent reinforcing steel corrosion at Wurtulla and Birtinya
- \$96,000 to remove and reconstruct 245m of concrete footpath along Parklands Boulevard, Little Mountain
- \$77,000 to replace 223m of asphalt pathway, along the Western side of Nicklin Way, from Stockland Park to the Sunshine Coast Stadium bus stop, Bokarina
- \$60,000 to renew playground at Tuldar Park, Wurtulla
- \$60,000 to replace playground at Anglia Park, Little Mountain
- \$41,500 to construct pedestrian refuge south of Hamilton Street, Meridan Plains
- \$25,000 to renew Basketball Court and landscaping at Crummunda Park, Wurtulla
- \$25,000 to replace 50m of concrete pathway at the north eastern end of Lake Kawana, Bokarina



- \$20,000 to replace picnic bench area at Aroona Park, Aroona
- \$20,000 to renew barbecue at Paul Niesler Park, Warana.
- \$11,000 to renew two seats in Tumbledown Park, Currimundi
- \$10,000 to decommission fence at Stockyard Park, Little Mountain
- \$7000 to renew obstacles and signs at Ridgehaven Dog Park, Aroona
- \$5000 to design the playground renewal at Noel Burns Park, Wurtulla
- \$5000 to renew barbecue at Lake Kawana Waterfront Park, East Bank, Bokarina
- \$10,000 to replace bollards and plant trees at Tumbledown Park at Currimundi and replace bollards at Ocean Ridge Park, Aroona
