Construction overview

Following completion of Monday night's planned line marking works (weather permitting) we are pleased to advise that the new four lane section of Brisbane Road, between Mayes Canal Bridge and Walan Street, is expected to OPEN on Tuesday morning, 20 December. This section includes the new signalised intersection at Tarcoola Avenue/Foote Street/Brisbane Road which replaces the previous roundabout.

Council and the construction contractor have worked hard to ensure that roads are operational before the peak Christmas - New Year holiday season. The extreme wet weather combined with ongoing supply issues impacting the construction industry have presented a few challenges.

We ask motorists to exercise caution as our community becomes familiar with the new traffic conditions.

As advised in our December Community Update newsletter the remaining two new lanes of the new Mayes Canal bridge and the bridge's timber viewing deck/shared pathway, along with some pedestrian pathways and landscaping will be completed in early 2023.

All construction will cease from 22 December 2022 to 8 January 2023 inclusive. Works will recommence on Monday 9 January 2023.
