

Proposed Amendment – Planning
Scheme Policy for Development Works

Background and Purpose

- 15 October 2020 Council resolved to amend the PSP for Development Works and place it on public consultation
- Amendment updates the engineering standards and specifications in the current policy
- Consider submissions received on the proposed amendment
- Seek Council's endorsement to adopt the proposed amendment, with changes





Summary of public consultation process

- Public consultation period 2 November to 4 December 2020
- 12 submissions received:-
 - ➤ 10 submissions outlined general support but raised a range of issues/concerns
 - 2 submissions raised matters outside scope of proposed amendment
- Consultation report provides a summary of issues raised and Council's proposed response and recommendations



Summary of key matters raised in submissions

- Road infrastructure kerb construction techniques & pavement thickness requirements
- Stormwater management design requirements
- Lighting requirements
- Local parks desired standards of service, maintenance of park infrastructure, local park embellishments and guidelines
- Landscaping infrastructure landscape design for wildlife, landscape requirements and landscape bonds
- Constructed waterbodies design requirements
- Specifications and construction checklists



Consideration of matters raised

- Range of drafting changes recommended:-
 - Address various technical issues
 - Address a drafting error
 - Address new or changed information
 - Provide further guidance and improve clarity and efficient operation of the policy



Recommendation

- Council proceed to adopt the proposed amendment, with changes
- If Council decides to adopt the proposed amendment, the next steps include:-
 - Provide a copy of the Consultation Report to all submitters
 - Place a public notice in a local newspaper
 - Prepare the planning scheme (incorporating the amendment) for commencement
