Plans, contractor revealed for Sunshine Coast Submarine Cable station


- **November 2018** – Australian-based Vertiv was awarded the contract to design and construct the cable landing station
- **\$6.6M cable landing station** designed to accommodate up to four submarine cables
- The landing station will be designed to reflect the vision for the **Maroochydore city centre**
- **\$15M contribution** from Queensland Government's Jobs and Regional Growth Fund

 **\$4.57 million** in revenue for Sunshine Coast Holiday Parks.

 **290** volunteers gave more than 13,000 hours-time at Council's libraries.


 **1272** hectares of landscape and garden beds maintained.

 **90%** of development applications assessed within statutory time-frames.

 **6 awards** awards received during the quarter.

 **1850** building approvals issued with a construction value of \$407 million.

 **8843** hectares managed for conservation under Sunshine Coast Land for Wildlife program.
