Signalisation of Pedestrian Crossing – Beerburrum Street, Aroona

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to improving pedestrian crossings across our region.

Works will begin soon on the upgrade of the pedestrian crossing at Beerburrum Street, Aroona which will provide a safe crossing to Ridgehaven Park.

The upgraded pedestrian crossing will include traffic/pedestrian lights and more road lighting.

Start date

Work is scheduled to start Monday 11 September. Residents adjacent to the works will be updated closer to commencement.

Construction is expected to be completed within three months, weather and site conditions permitting.

Your patience during construction is appreciated.

Tree Impacts

One tree will be removed to accommodate the pedestrian crossing. Three street trees will be planted along Beerburrum Street as offset planting. Please refer to Figure 1 overleaf.

Traffic management

Traffic management measures will be in place throughout construction to ensure the safety of all road users.

Construction crews will contact residents prior to starting any works which may affect property access.
