Park Improvements – Tete Park Conondale

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to maintaining and improving our parks and recreational spaces across our region. As part of these ongoing improvement works, Tete Park in Conondale will receive necessary upgrades.

This includes replacing timber bollards with boulders, installing a new vehicle gate, new park entry sign and some minor tree planting.

Start date

Works are scheduled to start in late February and will be completed within two weeks weather and site conditions permitting.

Property access and parking

There will be temporary fencing around the work site to ensure the safety of workers and our community.

There will be no impact to access or parking, and the park facilities will remain open to the public.
