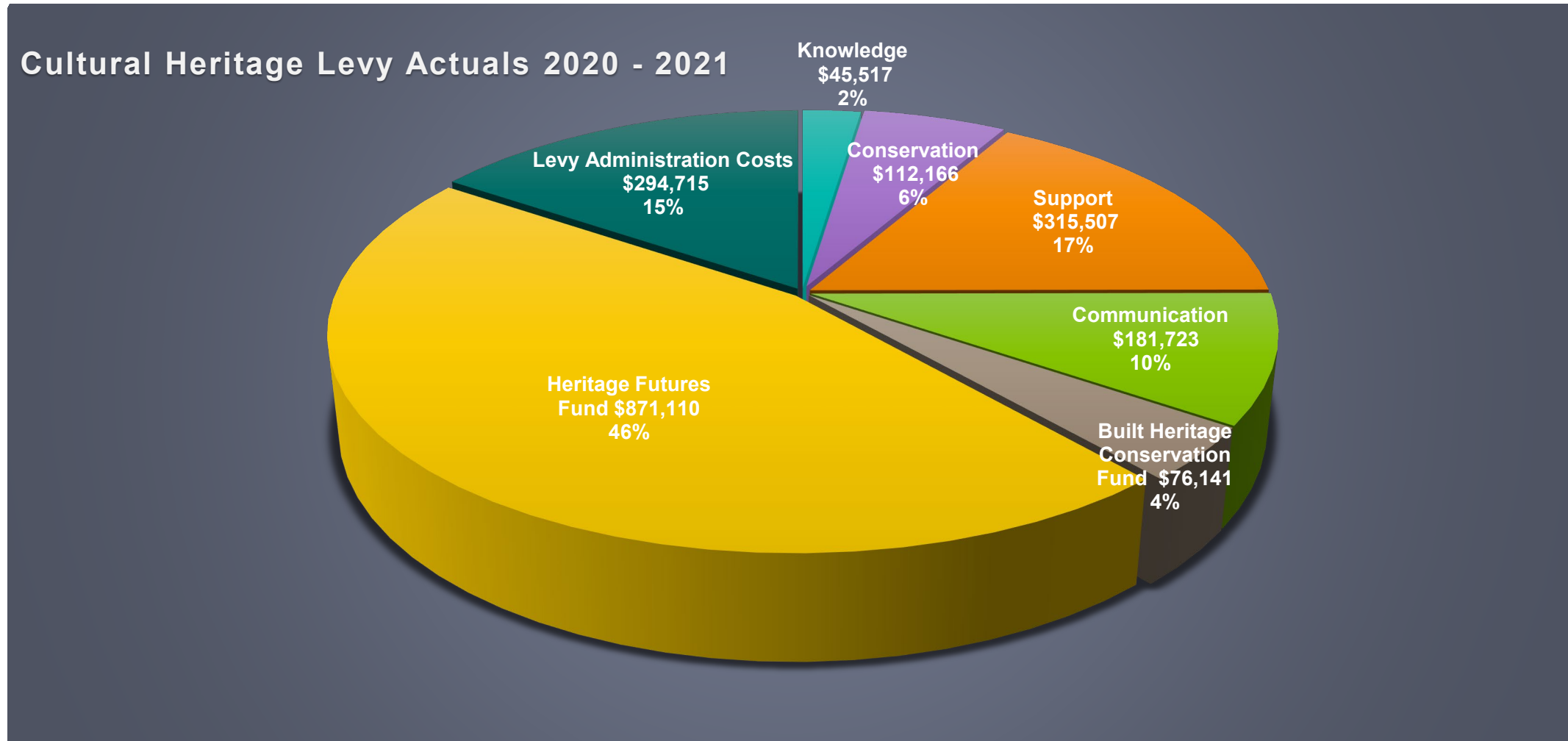

# Heritage Levy actuals (revenue and expenditure) 2020/21



# Key achievements 2020/21

- Sunshine Coast Heritage Plan 2021-2031 endorsed by Council in February 2021
- \$45,000+ for ongoing digitisation of significant regional collections and improved access to content through online platforms
- Updated Conservation Management Plans for Bankfoot House
- First Nations Virtual Reality program developed and launched. Winner of Museums and Galleries National Award (MAGNA) for Interpretation, Learning & Audience Engagement (Level 2)
- \$76,000+ from the Built Heritage Conservation Fund supported projects in Landsborough, Caloundra, Maleny, Witta, Conondale and Yandina
- \$183,000+ in grants for community heritage organisations and projects
- \$90,000+ for interpretive projects including digital stories, exhibitions, and trails
- \$60,000+ for heritage sector/audience educational seminars, business and skills development programs and activities
- Regional Heritage Discovery Guide re-developed and launched with supporting collateral to promote our community museums and heritage trails.
