# New Pathway – Cooinda Crescent, Maroochydhore

### Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council will be constructing a new footpath along the eastern side of Cooinda Crescent, Maroochydhore.

The new footpath will span from the Homemaker Centre carpark 160 metres along Cooinda Crescent.

This is part of a staged project to connect the Homemaker Centre to the existing footpath at Boongala Terrace.

Please refer to figure 1 overleaf for the location of this project.

### Start date

Works have been scheduled to start Monday 20 November 2023 and will be completed within two weeks.

Three trees will be removed to safely accommodate the new footpath. As part of Council's commitment to sustainability, a total of five trees will be planted as an offset.

### Property access and parking

Property access should not be affected during works. However, if the contractor does require access, then property owners will be notified in advance.

### Traffic management

It may be necessary to close the road shoulder to ensure safe access to the work site. On-street parking may be limited while works are underway.
