Pathway & Footbridge Upgrades – Quota Memorial Park, Nambour

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to improving and maintaining our green spaces and pathway networks across our region.

Works will begin next week on a new 3-metrewide footbridge across Petrie Creek. This new bridge will replace the existing one-metre-wide bridge which also has stairs. The new design will improve accessibility for all members of our community.

Park improvements will also start on realigning, extending and renewing the footpath within Quota Memorial Park.

Sections of grassed area will be reshaped to improve drainage towards the creek. Works will also be done to re-establish the amphitheatre terraced seating.

Start date

Bridge works are scheduled to start the week beginning Monday 19 February 2024 and are anticipated to be completed by end of June 2024.

Pathway works are currently planned to start early May 2024 and be completed by early June 2024.

Works will occur between 7am and 5pm on weekdays.

Pedestrian access and parking

Different areas of the park will be closed to pedestrians at varying stages through the works, however access across Petrie Creek will be always maintained. Please follow detour signage provided.

Some parking spaces on Matthew Street adjacent to the park will be impacted for extended periods.
