Construction overview

Construction is progressing on the new Stringybark Road pedestrian and cycle bridge which is located parallel to the existing vehicle bridge. This new three-metre wide bridge will provide a shared pathway for bicycle riders and pedestrians, separate from vehicles.

The \$11.8 million project is proudly supported by the Queensland Government's Cycle Network Local Government Grants program and Sunshine Coast Council.

In addition to the new bridge, the pathway on the existing vehicle bridge will be removed and the bridge reconfigured to provide on-road cycle lanes on both sides.

Additional temporary changes to traffic conditions

Traffic movements remain OPEN on Stringybark Road and the Sunshine Motorway.

Unfortunately some motorists are continuing to speed through the construction zone, particularly on the Sunshine Motorway.

To further protect our community and the safety of onsite construction workers, additional traffic safety measures will be implemented from Sunday 19 May until further notice. These include:

- An 80km per hour transition zone (between the 100km and 60km signs and the construction zone)
- Speed cameras. Infringement notices will be issued to drivers not observing the changed traffic conditions.

Please see the diagram on **page two** of this notification which shows the reduced speed area.

Some road lane closures may be implemented at times for safety reasons. STOP/GO Traffic control will in operation as required.
