### Queensland Waste Strategy


- Underpinned by a waste disposal levy -\$85 per tonne 2021-22
- Loss of waste levy advance payment
- 65% waste diversion target 2025
- SCC currently 37%
- 55.8% of bin waste organic compostable

Short Term

• Weekly Waste

• Fortnightly opt-out GO





## Community Engagement

- 84% agree it is very important to provide a service to reduce organic waste in landfill
- 74% of respondents support 'opt-out' garden waste bin











# Food Organics Garden Organics

### **Community Engagement**

- 83% would support FOGO bin collection service
- 54.5% of respondents report cost is very important









# Organics Waste Collection Options Analysis

- local climate not conducive with keeping food waste in bins for longer than one week, odour and amenity issues
- service involving the collection of both the general waste bin and the organic waste bin on a weekly basis would result in significantly higher service costs





### Garden Organics


### **Opt-out GO**

- Improves landfill diversion rate increasing landfill life
- Reduces greenhouse gas emissions contributing to Councils Environment and Liveability Strategy to be a zeronet emissions organization
- Service to all residential properties
  - Exemption criteria to be developed



#### **FOGO**

- significantly improves landfill diversion and reduces greenhouse gas emissions
- Service to all properties
  - No exemptions
