**ROAD OVER RAIL BRIDGE, BURGESS STREET – GLASS HOUSE MOUNTAINS**

Thank you for your letter of 6 March 2015. Queensland Rail does not accept your advice that the Burgess Street road overbridge is the responsibility of the Rail Manager.

As you have advised, the Burgess Street road overbridge was constructed in 1968. At that time Burgess Street was a State controlled road managed by the Main Roads Department. This road overbridge was designed and constructed by Main Roads to Main Roads standards. At that time the Main Roads Department accepted responsibility for the maintenance of the bridge. The design drawings for the bridge are Main Roads Department drawings.

As you have also advised, the Burgess Street was subsequently de-mained by the Main Roads Department and gazetted as a Local Government Road in 1981. By legislative definition, the Burgess Street road overbridge is the responsibility of Sunshine Coast Regional Council and the responsibility of Council to maintain.

I do not accept your proposed changes to the draft road/rail interface agreement.
