



Mar 2022 Council endorse applications


June 2025 Permits expire

# A total of 29 activities and locations are proposed for the 2022-2025 period

Removed	Changed
Tandem Skydiving & Parachute Landings at Bulcock Beach, Kings Beach, and Moffat Beach	Stand-Up Paddle at Charles Clark Park Mooloolaba, changed to Pedal Boat Hire
Kayak Tours at Moffat Beach	Surf based business at Mooloolaba Beach extended to operate between Beach Access 182 - 194

Annual rental fee Calculated based on the area used by the business	\$108 per sqm

Discounts on annual rental fee	Discount
Part time use of council-controlled land  Discount applied based on conditions outlined in Appendix B	50%
Multiple permit holder Discount applied based on conditions outlined in Appendix B	25%





### Implementation

   EOIs are opened
- 12 December 2021
   EOIs are closed
- January 2022
   Panel assessment of the EOIs
- March 2022
   Assessment results presented to Council for endorsement
- March 2022
   Applicants notified of the outcome of the EOI process
- June 2022
   Permits are issued for successful applicants to operate from 1 July 2022 30 June 2025
