Construction overview

As we move into the final few months of the new streetscape's construction, April works will include ongoing:

- footpath and kerb construction
- electrical and lighting works
- irrigation works
- landscaping works - including new turf, planting and street furniture installation.

Traffic flow will be maintained along Blackall Street with pedestrian/customer access remaining available to all businesses.

For safety reasons some on street car parking areas will be temporarily inaccessible during these works. Traffic control will be in operation as required.

All businesses remain OPEN as per normal trading hours. We thank you for continuing to support local businesses during construction.

Construction program – Zone One

April works. Ongoing footpath, kerb and landscaping works.

From Hill Street-Blackall Street intersection along Blackall Street, past the School of Arts Hall and Library, across the pub and bottle shop driveway and through to Frankie's Café.

Adjacent to Woombye Rural Supplies.

Pedestrian and vehicle access remains available to all businesses.

For Woombye Rural Supplies, access remains available to the driveway and free parking at the rear of the shop.

May works. Dates TBA

Final streetscape works will include:

- installation of the second raised pedestrian crossing on Blackall Street (in the same location as the existing crossing between SPAR Woombye and QML Pathology)
- minor asphalt works
- line marking
- street signage

The above works have been rescheduled to minimise inconvenience to the community by considering the upcoming Easter, ANZAC Day and Labour Day public holiday periods.

For safety reasons May works will include some temporary changes to traffic conditions, particularly when the second pedestrian crossing is being constructed.

We will provide further details in the next update.

What to expect during construction

Some temporary changes to access and on street parking areas will be required for safety reasons.

Large trucks and machinery will be operating including the use of concrete saws, jackhammers, and concrete trucks.

Some partial lane closures and traffic control may be required when machinery is operating.

While the construction team will try to mitigate noise as much as possible, intermittent noise is to be expected.

Dust mitigation measures will be in place.
