

COUNCILLOR COMMENT

Council's major carpark within the CBD section of Nambour is situated on the corner of Howard Street and Sydney Street.

On the 14th February 1973 the then Maroochy Shire Council allowed Infrastructure Development to be endorsed whereby Council accepted cash contributions of \$300 per car parking space (ten in total) in lieu of the required carparking spaces which

couldn't be constructed on the private development land, as conditioned by the Development Approval.

Over many decades, I assume Council has entered into various 'Carparking' arrangements with the owners of the business sites.

For the last 10 years, 10 parking permits had been issued to these businesses which allowed business owners and staff to have unlimited timed carparking within the Sydney/Howard Street Council Carpark.

Whilst the permits allowed unlimited time parking, they didn't guarantee an 'available space.'

This year permits were issued and then rescinded, as Transport Management Officers advised that the historical parking permits were not supported by a Council Local Law.
