Fence Replacement - Saltwater Way Park, Coolum

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to maintaining and improving our parks and recreational spaces across our region.

As part of these ongoing improvement works we are replacing the boundary fence adjacent to Saltwater Way Park and David Low Way.

Like-for-like replacement exceeds the allocated budget for this project, and previous materials used are deemed not fit for purpose or value for money.

We are replacing the ageing fence with a new fence of the same height, providing a safe and effective sound barrier between the park and the road. The new fence will be easy to maintain and its simple form and natural colouring will also blend well with the environment.

Start date

Works are scheduled to start mid-March and will be completed within two to three weeks, weather and site conditions permitting.

Property access and parking

There will be no impact to access or parking, and the park facilities will remain open to the public.

There will be signage and bunting around the work site to ensure the safety of our community and workers.
