Detours in place. Pedestrian and traffic control in place. Construction crew and machinery on site and roadway.

Construction overview

Despite the poor weather of the past few months, construction is progressing well on the new 160 metre long section of Caloundra Headland Coastal Pathway Boardwalk which is expected to be complete by late July 2024 (weather and site conditions permitting). This section forms part of a total 73 kilometre long coastal pathway route from Bells Creek in the south to Coolum in the north.

For safety reasons during construction temporary changes to traffic conditions are required. This also allows the construction team to work more efficiently and reduce the construction duration, thereby minimising inconvenience to residents and visitors.

Construction activity

May and June activity will see the installation of timber and stainless-steel balustrading along the boardwalk, electrical works including low-level pathway lighting, landscaping and the reinstatement of the RSL Memorial plaques.

Intermittent medium level construction noise can continue to be expected during the day.

Large machinery will be in place onsite and working from the roadway.

Caloundra AHS Centaur Memorial Service 14 May 2024 - new location

As coordinated by the Caloundra RSL, the memorial service usually held in Centaur Park Kings Beach will be relocated this year to take place at the RSL Memorial Gardens, 19 West Terrace, Caloundra. This will ensure the service is not interrupted by any construction activity. Signs are in place to advise of the new service location.

RSL Memorial plaques

Council, in coordination with the Caloundra RSL, has recorded, cleaned and safely stored all the memorial plaques that were originally located in the now removed section of concrete pathway.

The plaques will be reinstated within the new pathway and boardwalk balustrade, in the same order as previous. We thank the RSL for assisting Council with this important part of our community's history.
