Kawana Aquatic Centre Upgrade

Project summary

Sunshine Coast Council is committed to enhancing sport and recreation spaces across our region.

Major upgrades are being delivered for Kawana Aquatic Centre to ensure our community has access to world-class sporting amenities close to home.

The first stage of construction involves:

Stage 1A




Figure 2: The existing undercover pool will be replaced with a 20-metre indoor learn-to-swim pool

- demolition of the existing undercover pool (refer to Figure 2)
- construction of a new 20-metre indoor learn-to-swim pool
- improved structures, plant, and operating equipment

Stage 1B

 demolition of the existing 20-metre indoor learn-to-swim pool and then turfing the area to provide new open grass space (refer to Figure 1).

Local building firm Murphy Builders is appointed to deliver Stage 1A and 1B works.

Timing for Stage 2 and Stage 3 is still to be determined.

Future works include a new entry building, children's water play areas, public amenities, a refurbished kiosk, and improved car parking.

Construction has been staged to minimise inconvenience to our community.

Project timeline

Work is scheduled to start the week beginning Monday 20 March 2023.

Construction is expected to be completed by December, weather and site conditions permitting.

What to expect during construction

The Kawana Aquatic Centre will remain fully operational during construction.

Some short-term interruption may occur within the Aquatic Centre carpark.

Intermittent noise can be expected, including concrete saws in operation, demolition and construction workers on site, and construction vehicles accessing and leaving the location.

We thank patrons and surrounding businesses for your patience and understanding as we maintain and upgrade this much-loved community facility.
