

## ATTACHMENT 1 – SUMMARY OF SUBMISSIONS RECEIVED

During the consultation phase, council undertook a range of activities to raise awareness within the community. These activities included:

- Spotlight radio advertisements
- Spotlight newspaper advertisements
- Information on council's website and intranet site
- Notices on council's social networking applications
- Media Releases
- Council E-News
- Councillor Newsletters
- Sunshine Coast Daily Classified Advertisement

There was significant take up in the local print media that gained regional coverage several times throughout the consultation period.

### State interest checks

1. Consultation Period – 23 May 2014 to 22 June 2014
2. Submissions were invited from 5 State agencies as identified as relevant to the proposed amendments, including:
  - Department of Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry
  - Department of Environment and Heritage Protection
  - Department of Local Government, Community Recovery and Resilience
  - Department of National Parks, Recreation, Sport and Racing
  - Department of Health
3. Submissions/responses received by State agencies had **no issues** with the proposed changes

### Community consultation

1. Consultation Period – 23 May 2014 to 22 June 2014
2. Submissions were invited from the public.
3. **249** Submissions/responses were received, the topics were :
  - Local Law No.2 (Animal Management) – Cat Registration**  
**67 total submissions (48 Agreed – 14 Disagreed – 5 Did not relate to proposed amendment)**
  - Subordinate Local Law No.2 (Animal Management) - Dogs in eating establishments**  
**182 total submissions (149 Agreed – 28 Disagreed – 5 Did not relate to proposed amendment)**
