The Australian Government, Queensland Government and Sunshine Coast Council have upgraded the public boat ramp and trailer parking at Outrigger Park, Minyama.

New features include:

- An upgraded two-lane boat ramp
- An upgraded sealed car park with
 - 32 car-trailer parking bays
 - 14 standard vehicle parking bays
 - One PWD parking bay
- New turfed and landscaped areas.

We wish all users safe boating and happy paddling.

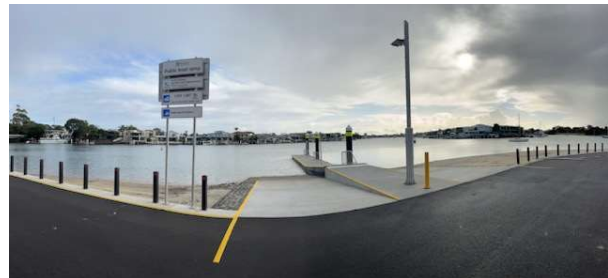


Figure 1: Two lane boat ramp at Outrigger Park.
